As a tribute to Mary Shelley and her famous book Frankenstein that celebrates this summer its 200th Anniversary, the Bodmer Museum has put together an exhibition called Frankenstein: Creation of Darkness. In 1816, at the Villa Diadati (the residence of Lord Byron), Mary Shelley found inspiration to write the world famous fiction. The exhibition recreates the beginnings of the novel featuring the different printed forms but also a manuscript and paintings/engravings that evoke the world of 1816. The book's main themes: Science and society have evolved through the years, yet they have kept their controversial spirit.
